

Treasure Coast United Soccer Club

Registration

Existing TCU players should have all registration paperwork turned in during tryout week.

New players will be notified by the Team Manager or Club Representative of acceptance to the club at the close of tryouts or shortly afterward. Instructions for returning registration paperwork and fees will be given at that time. Players will not be officially registered to the club until the club registration fee is paid in full and all registration forms have been received.

A \$25.00 late fee will be applied to any club registration fee payments after **XXXXXXXXXX**. A “No Pay, No Play” policy will be in effect as of **XXXXXXXXXX**. This means no player passes will be issued for players that have unpaid balances or have not established a payment plan.

Club Fees

Club fees cover the entire seasonal training program which roughly coincides with the Martin County School district calendar year which is approximately 9 months (late August to early June). Payment instructions are included in the registration packet. There is a 10% discount on the club training fee for siblings of existing TCU players. This discount applies only to the second or third players from a family.

Club Registration Fee: \$175 for U9 and above players

Club Training Fee: \$325 for U9 and U10 players
 \$525 for U11 and above players

Team Expenses

Each team has its own bank account managed by a team representative. Expenses for individual teams are paid out of these accounts. Individual team expenses not covered by the club registration fee or club training fees are; league referee fees, tournament entry fees, tournament expenses and individual team trainer expenses. Funds for the team bank accounts can be generated by individual team fundraising and/or player contributions. Team Expenses for the younger age teams are generally minimal depending on how many tournaments the team attends. Expenses increase for older teams attending distant tournaments.

Uniforms

Uniforms are not included in the club registration fee. All new and returning TCU players will need to order the basic uniforms kit, which includes: a game jersey, alternate jersey, practice jersey, shorts and socks. Players may order additional items as needed. The club is purchasing quality uniforms at a discount which is passed on to the players. A uniform order form is included in the registration packet and needs to be filled out at registration time. Samples for sizing purposes will be available. Uniform kit prices are listed on the order forms.

All practices are held at Leighton Park in Palm City. The proposed schedule below may change as needed:

Club Structure

Treasure Coast United Inc. is a Florida non-profit corporation under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and contributions are tax deductible. The Federal EIN is 75-3076535. The Treasure Coast United Soccer Club consists of dedicated volunteer board members, team managers, parent volunteers, and professional trainers.

Tournaments & Leagues

The soccer season starts in late August and ends Memorial Day Weekend. Players should be committed throughout the entire season. U9 thru U14 teams typically play a winter (regular) league, and enter three or more tournaments during the season including a Labor Day tournament in the fall and a Memorial Day tournament in the spring. Some U9 thru U14 teams may opt to play in a fall (early season) league as well. U15 and above teams may opt to play in fall (early season) league or enter several tournaments before the High School season begins. Some U15 and above teams may enter tournaments during the High School season, and all older teams enter several high level College Showcase tournaments in the spring. Expenses associated with tournaments and league referee fees are paid for by the individual teams by team fundraising or player contributions.

End of Season Awards Banquet

Near the end of the soccer season the entire club (players, parents and coaches) gather to celebrate the past season. This is the most important and prestigious event of the year. Awards for Coaches Player of the Year, Player's Player of the Year, Most Improved Player of the Year, as well as a Junior and Senior Player of the Year are awarded. All TCU players are expected to attend.

Fundraising & Sponsors

Players are free to seek outside sponsors to cover the full or partial cost of their club registration, training and uniform kit fees. A sponsor letter is available from the club for this purpose. Contributions can be made payable to Treasure Coast United Soccer Club and can be credited directly to a player's account. Various other fundraising activities conducted by individual players and teams can cover other expenses associated with playing premier level travel soccer.
