SEASON PLAYER/CLUB EXPECTATIONS AGREEMENT

Congratulations on being selected to join the Treasure Coast United Soccer Club (TCU) for the 2011-2012 Season. Your skills and hard work have earned you a spot in one of the top soccer clubs in Florida. Our coaches and Board of Directors hope that this will be an enjoyable year for you and your family. We want to ensure that you understand the commitments TCU is making to you at this time and our expectations of you as a player/parent in this club. TCU is a premier competitive soccer club; there is no guarantee of minimum playing time. In the interest of player development, players will occasionally cross-train or guest play between gender or age groups, and/or guest play outside the Club (e.g. college showcase opportunities). Notwithstanding a player's team placement within the Club in a preceding year, TCU team rosters are decided by the coaching staff and no guarantees are made as to a player's placement on a particular team or age group within the Club.

TCU will provide the following:

1. TCU will provide a comprehensive soccer program using the Coerver Coaching method which is designed to maximize each player's fullest potential. Each player will be assigned to a team that will have a Team Manager/Coach working closely with the club training staff.
2. In an effort to develop every player, teams will train twice a week for a majority of the season and play in league and /or tournament games. Each team will be entered into a league and/or tournaments that meet their ability, including but not limited to SFUL, FLUGSA, TCSL, PBSL, BYSL, US Club Soccer Events, and FYSA Region and State Cup. Individual teams will be responsible for league referee fees and tournament entry fees and associated trainer expenses.
3. The club coaching staff will work with each Team Manager to determine the tournaments and programming that will be appropriate for each team and player.

Player & Parent Responsibilities

1. Our season starts in late August and ends Memorial Day Weekend. Players should be committed throughout this entire season. Player and parents are expected to support all our events 100%. Accepting a position in the club obligates each player to pay the full non-refundable registration and training fees, regardless of whether the player later decides to leave TCU prior to the end of the seasonal year.
2. From time to time, there will be team expenses above and beyond the club registration and training fees. Team expenses may include tournament fees, extra soccer gear, team trainer fees and travel reimbursement, referee fees for tournaments and league games, and travel costs associating with attending these events. Players and/or teams may seek and receive donations and/or fundraise to defray these expenses. To the extent such donations and/or fundraising amounts are deposited into team accounts, they may be used to pay for such expenses. These funds will remain with TCU should the player or group of players decide to leave the Club, with any unused amount remaining in the team account.
3. Each player and parent has received and read the FYSA Code of Ethics and agrees to abide by those requirements. By signing below, each player and parent accepts a position with TCU and agrees to act in a respectful manner at all practices, games, and club events and serve as role models to others.
4. TCU will request each player/parent to volunteer for various club activities during the season. These duties may include but are not limited to: field marshalling, registration, concession sales, or assigned team tasks for designated event.
